

## Instructions for Students in MES42 Integrated Algebra

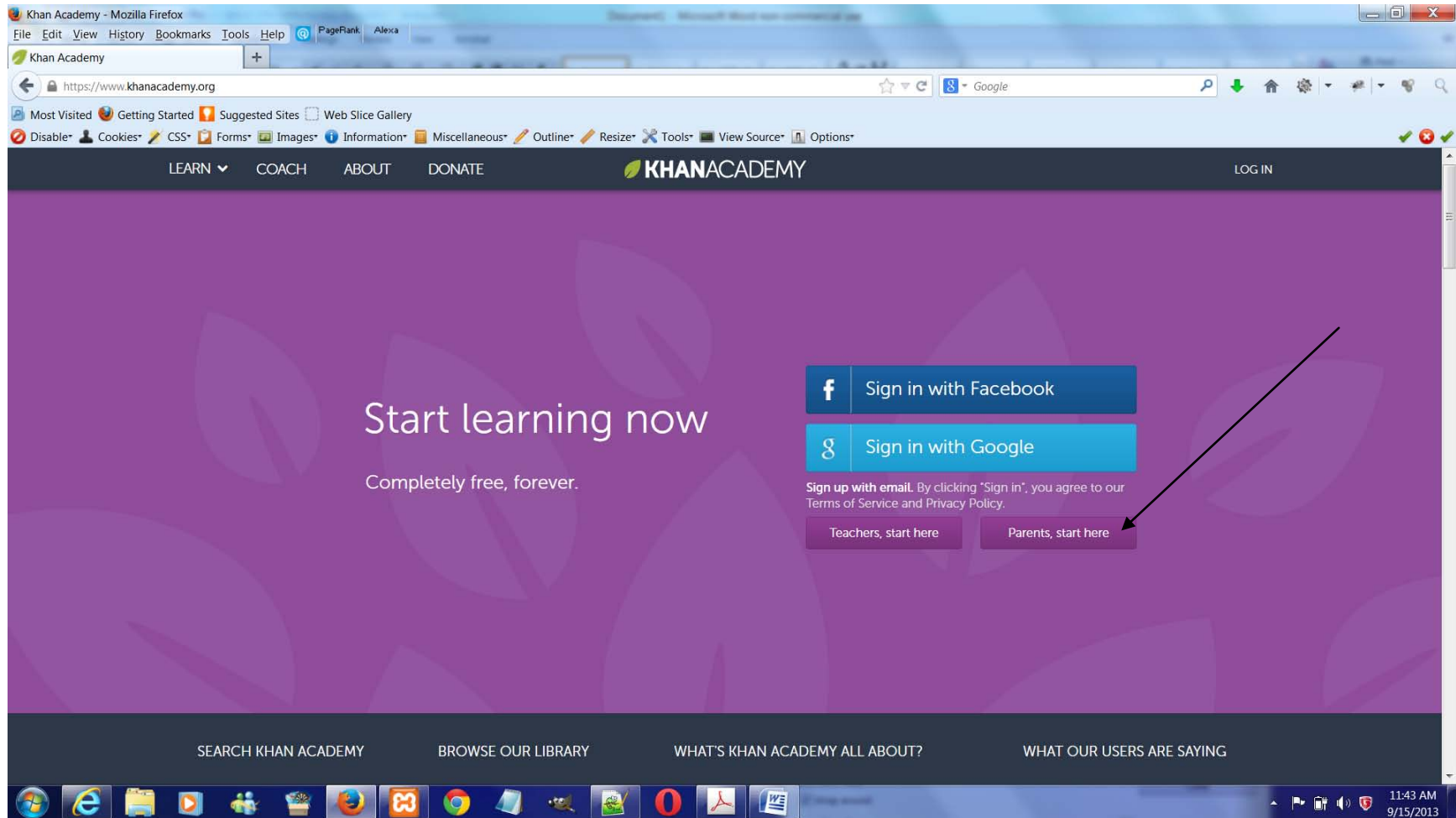
- 1) Create an account on [www.khanacademy.org](http://www.khanacademy.org) and join the class. In order for your homework to be recorded you must make sure that you have joined the class the code is: HU6BPT and that you are logged in each time that you do an assignment. For instructions on joining the class see pp. 2 -10 of this link.
- 2) Click on the homework link for your class on the Web page (third link) to find the assigned homework. The homework can include problems from the khanacademy, regentsprep.org and/or problems from the worksheet link of the website.
- 3) If the assignment includes problems from khanacademy, then click on the link, and make sure that you log in. You must do the homework from the assigned links from madisonmath.com. If Khan tells you to get 5 in a row correct, then try at least 10 attempts, and when he asks for 3 correct in a row, try 5 attempts. If the assignment includes problems from the worksheet, click on the worksheet link for your class on the Web page (directly below the link for these instructions) and find the appropriate worksheet. If you did not print out the worksheet write out the question and answer the question of on a separate sheet of paper. When applicable, draw and label diagrams. Copy all assigned problems from the text on a separate sheet of paper, and draw out all diagrams, tables, etc...
- 4) You may only use an approved calculator.. Answer all test questions in blue or black ink; only use a pencil for diagrams and tables.

### **5) Supplies:**

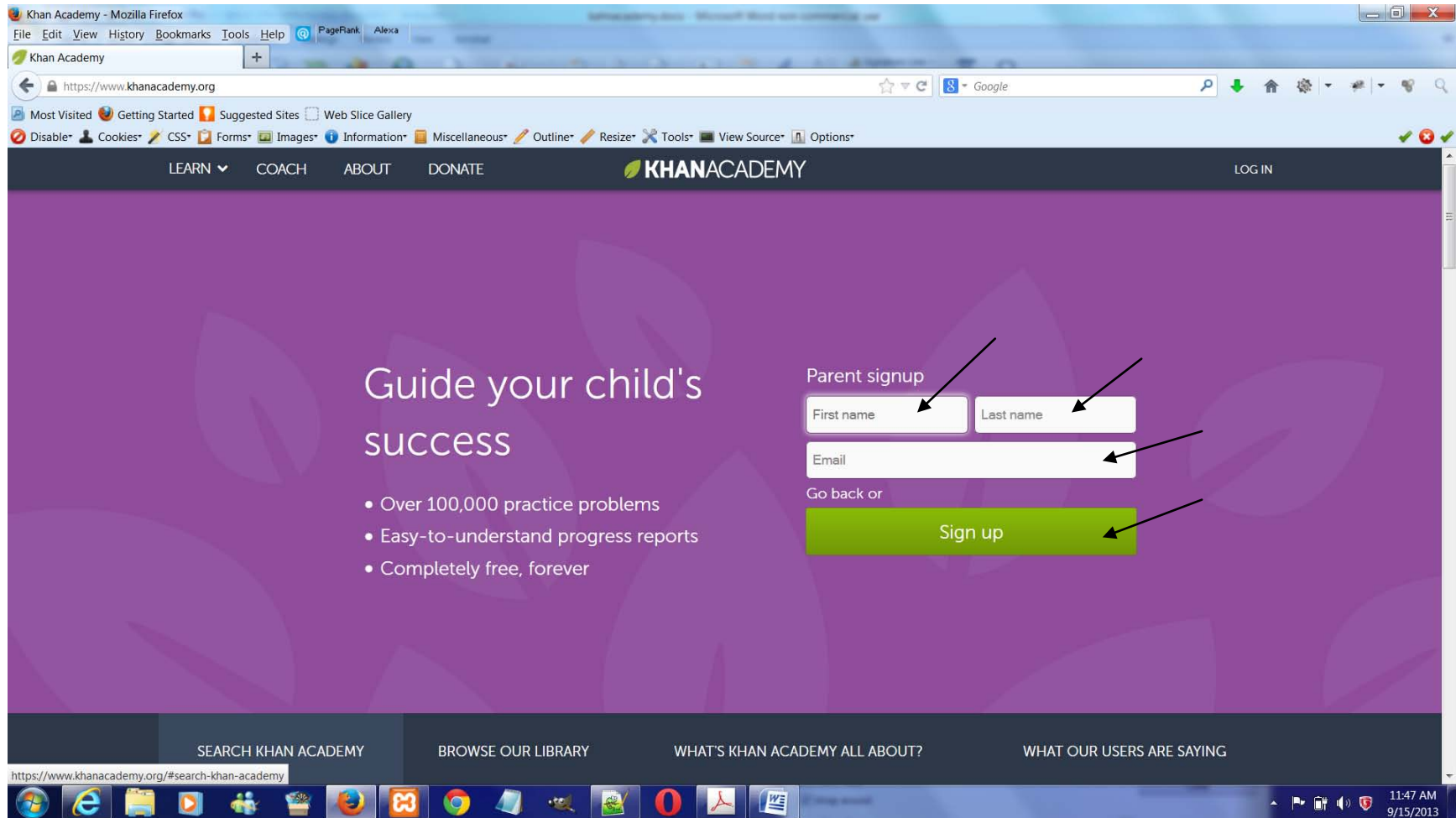
- 2 separate sections in your binder – one for math and another for homework. You may use a notebook for notes, and then do all homework on separate sheets of paper.
- A math folder to store worksheets, tests, homework, and a few sheets of graph paper
- Pens – blue or black ink ( at least 3), pencils, eraser, sharpener
- An approved calculator
- Miscellaneous – tissues, etc... so you do not have to leave the room to find anything during class

- 6) For extra practice visit [www.regentsprep.org](http://www.regentsprep.org) jmap.org, and other sites as well.

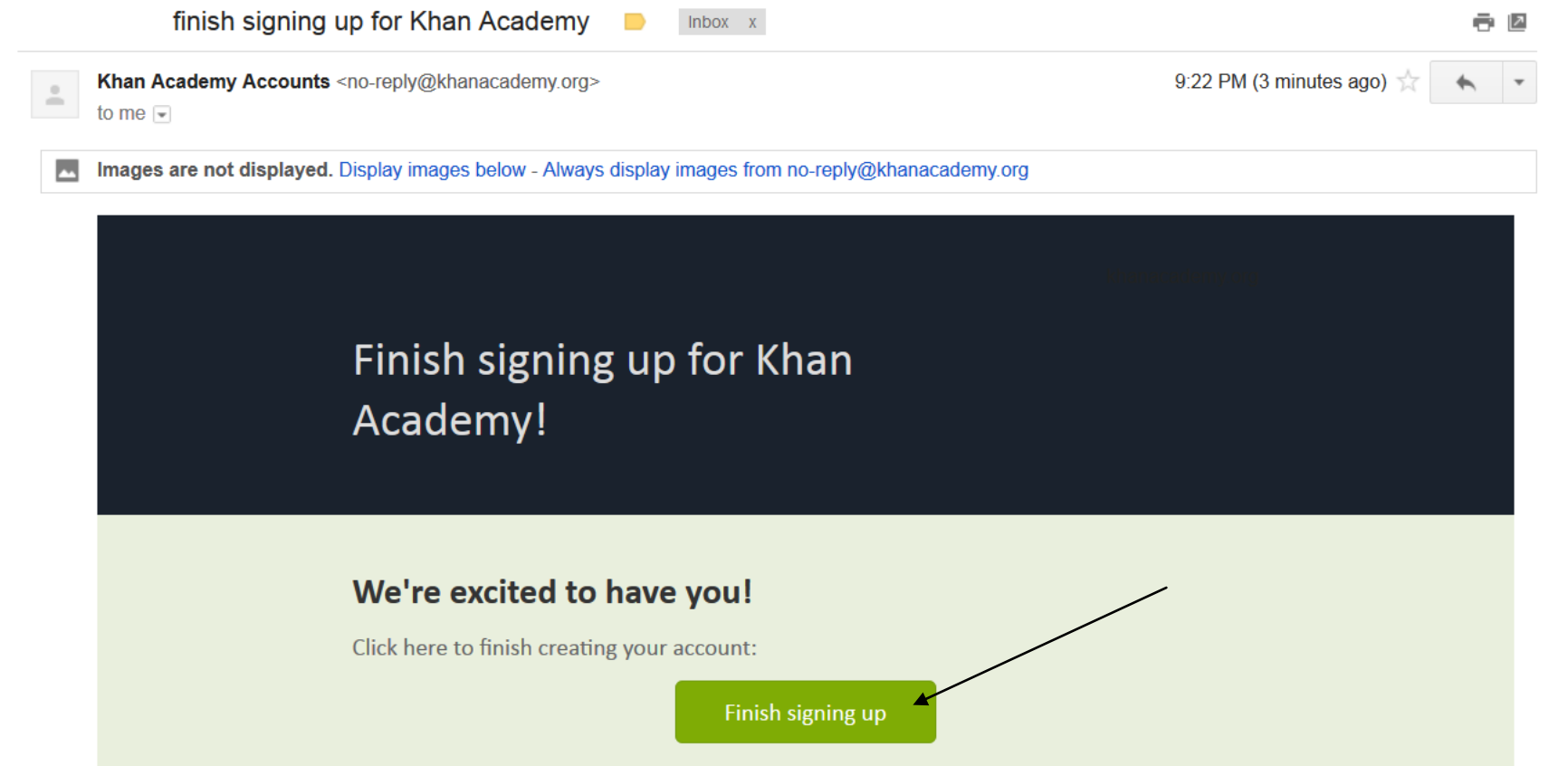
1) Parent should first go to the website: [www.khanacademy.org](http://www.khanacademy.org) and press on the “Parents, start here” button.



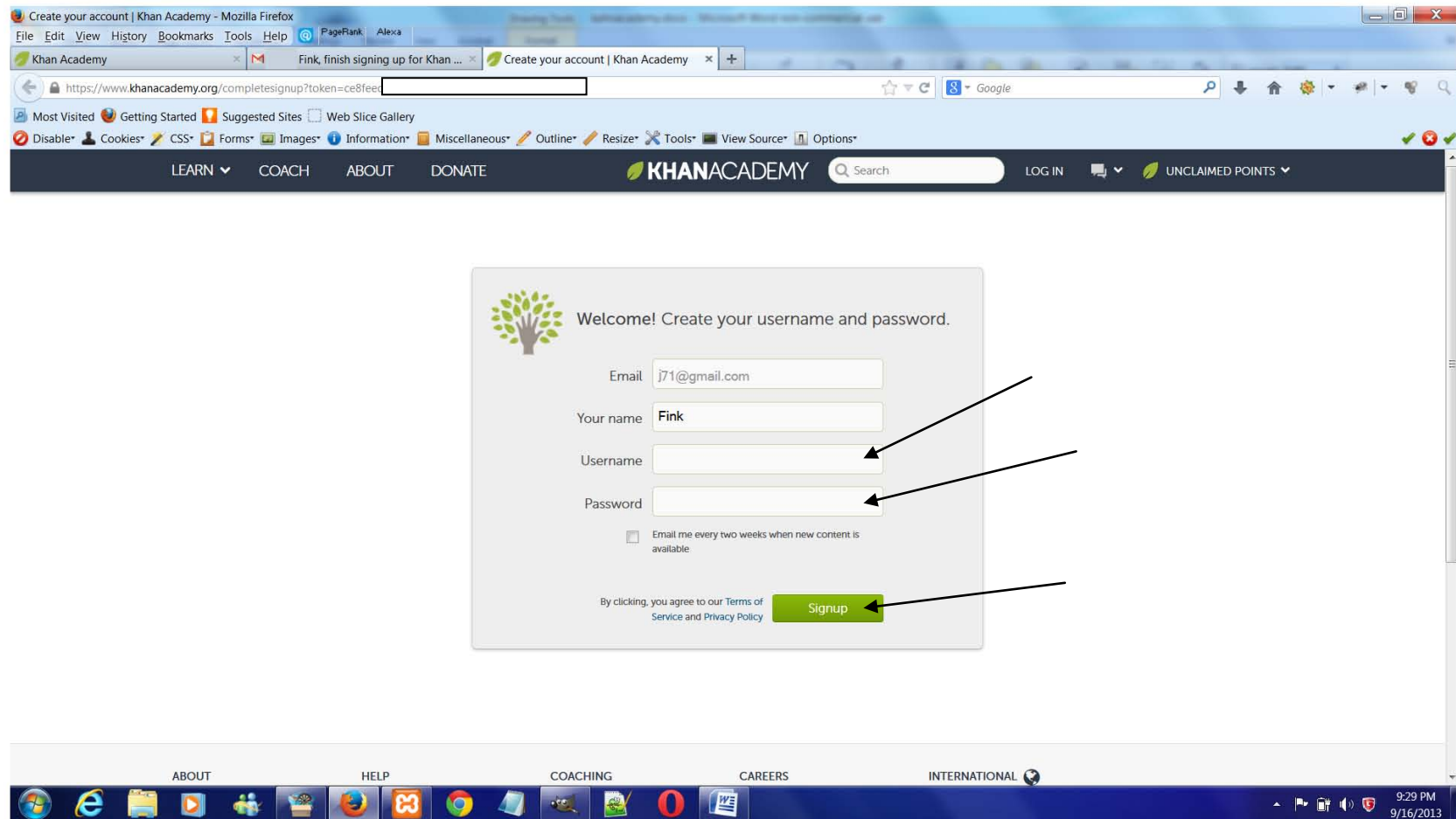
2) Next, parent should enter their first name, last name and email address and then press the “Sign up” button.



3) [www.khanacademy.org](http://www.khanacademy.org) will then send an email to your email account and you must login to your account and press the “Finish signing up” button.



4) You will then be taken to the [www.khanacademy.org](http://www.khanacademy.org) site and your email and name will be displayed and you must enter a Username and a Password (which you should create just for this site) and then press the Signup button.



5) Then you must enter your child's birthday and his/her username and his/her password (which you should create only for this site) so that they can sign in. **It is critical that you keep the checkbox checked next to the "Allow your child to add other coaches", because that will allow me to assign your child homework using this system.** Then press the "Create account" button.

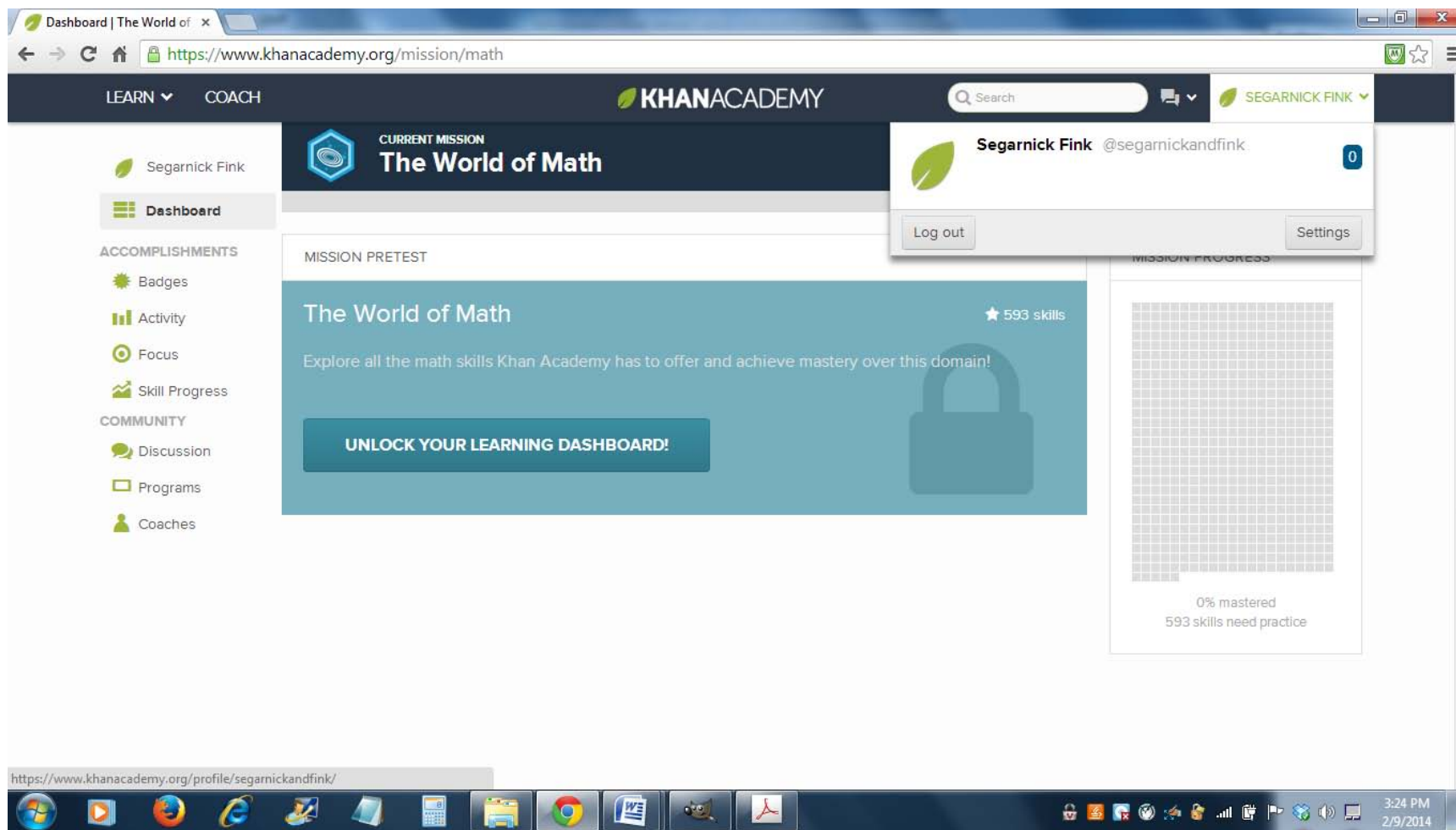

6) Then click on your name, in the top right corner, (which will appear instead of ours) and then a dropdown box will appear, which is on the next page of this document. (If at any point, a message appears about your profile or a tour, you may click no thanks for the time being)

7) When you see the dropdown menu, click on your name again – do not click on Log out or Settings. You will see your name instead of ours.



8) Wait for the page to load so that you see the following menu of options on the left side of the screen. Then click on the coaches icon, which is the last icon on the bottom of the menu.

You should now see my email address: Segarnickandfink@yahoo.com as one of your coaches and you are finished with the process. Just remember that each time that you do homework, that you are logged in so that your credit will be recorded (and that you have also already joined the class).
